- Members will maintain a neutral stance on political matters while representing the DG Unlimited in any capacity.
- Members must not disclose or make any other use of confidential information to which they have access other than for a proper purpose relating to the performance and delivery of work and services of DG Unlimited.
- Members must disclose any interest which they may have (or might be seen to have) when they are asked to provide services for DG Unlimited. Members must also disclose any interest that could otherwise prejudice any service they are asked to perform on behalf of DG Unlimited.
- Members must always ensure mutual trust and respect and that differences in opinion are respected.
- There is a visible commitment from Members to promote equality and diversity, Fair Work, and environmental sustainability in all areas of DG Unlimited's work and services to the Creative and Cultural Sector.
